Alternative Terminal Keystrokes

Use the **F1** button on any page of a ThinManager wizard to launch Help for that page.

WinTMC creates an RDP connection to a terminal server. Some keystrokes, like *CTL+ALT+DEL*, aren't available while using WinTMC because they act on the local machine.

Microsoft has provided these alternatives.

Keystroke	Replaces	Function
ALT+PAGE UP	ALT+Tab	Switches between programs from left to right.
ALT+PAGE DOWN	ALT+Shift+Tab	Switches between programs from right to left.
ALT+INSERT	ALT+ESC	Cycles through the programs in the order they were started.
ALT+HOME	CTL+ESC	Displays the Start menu.
CTRL+ALT+BREAK		Switches the client between a window and full screen.
CTRL+ALT+END	CTL+ALT+DEL	Brings up the Windows Security dialog box.
ALT+DELETE		Displays the Windows menu.
CTRL+ALT+Minus (-) symbol on the numeric keypad	ALT+PrintScreen	Places a snapshot of the active window, within the client, on the Terminal server clipboard (provides the same functionality as pressing PrintScrn on a local computer.)
CTRL+ALT+Plus (+) symbol on the numeric keypad	CTL+PrintScreen	Places a snapshot of the entire client window area on the Terminal server clipboard (provides the same functionality as pressing ALT+PrintScrn on a local computer.)
