Tuesdays – 8-hour lab – System Integrators and OEMs who complete the lab training will become ThinManager Certified Partners.

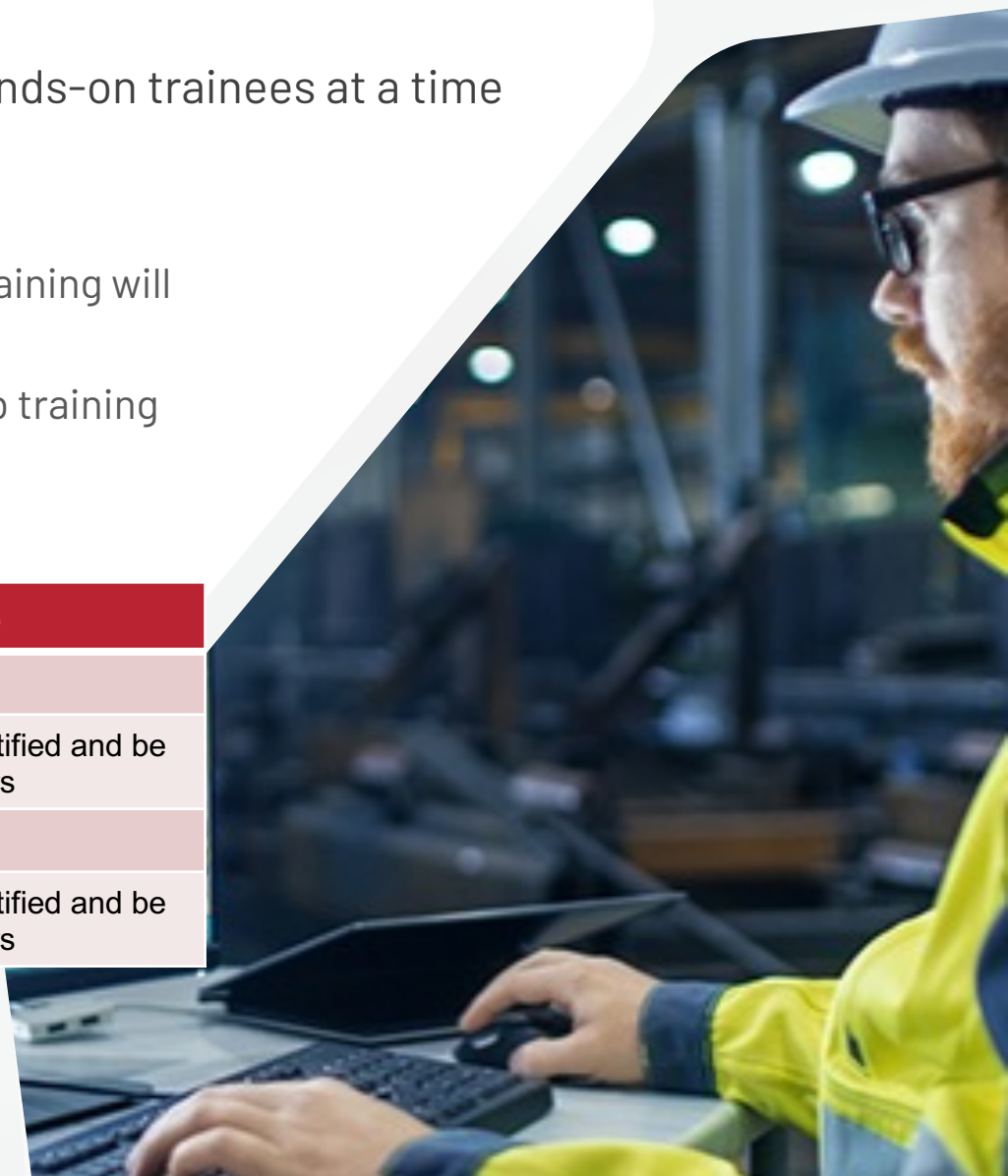

3 Steps to Host Training

Step 1 – Request a Week to Host ThinManager Roadshow Training

Follow instructions to request a ThinManager SI-OEM Training Roadshow

- **Fill in the Roadshow request form at <https://thinmanager.com/roadshow/request>**
 - ThinManager Training Roadshows are available in-person for 2024.
 - You will be contacted by the ThinManager events team once your submission has been reviewed.
 - If approved, your event will be added to the roadshow schedule and resources assigned.
 - Training content is provided on Tuesdays and Wednesdays of available weeks.

Step 2 – Invite SIs, OEMs to Roadshow Training

Get people registered for your event

- **Once your event has been approved and added to the schedule, you will receive marketing materials from the ThinManager events team that you may use to invite participants. Here's what is included...**
 - **ThinManager will be hosting the event registration forms for this year's training.** You will receive a unique URL (link) to use to get people to register for your event. Each full-day of training will have a unique registration link.
 - A PDF with course description and details that you can attach to email invitations will be provided.
- **Invitations should be sent to appropriate recipients only. Please do not invite End-Users. They will not be permitted to attend.**
- **Internet access is required for participants.**

Step 3 – Maintain the Roadshow Training Guidelines

ThinManager training guidelines for 2024

- **Limit of 12 for hands-on MR Demo training (*registration forms enforce this limit*)**
 - **Training space must be adequate** to accommodate the hands-on demo kits. A **minimum 6-foot table** is required per user, in order to provide enough room for all the training equipment. For the SI, OEM Certification training, working as a team will not receive certification. **Students are not permitted to work together.**
- **These are the requirements for each week of training:**
 - At 14 days prior to your event, you must have a minimum of 18 registrants (e.g. 9 registrants for Tuesday, and 9 registrants for Wednesday) in order to maintain the MR Demo kit shipping for hands-on training. If you do not have the minimum registrants at 14 business days prior to your event, it will automatically change to cloud-based training, and no MR Demo kits will be shipped. Virtual events will only be offered on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- **Registrations for each lab are final two days prior to the training event. Tuesday event registrations will be finalized Friday of the previous week and Wednesday registrations will be finalized by end of day on Monday prior to the training event.**
