

DNS Configuration

Use the F1 button on any page of a ThinManager wizard to launch Help for that page.

ThinManager allows you to define a Domain Name Server to identify terminal servers instead of relying on IP addresses.

Select <u>Manage > DNS Configuration</u> from the ThinManager menu to launch the **Domain Name Server** Wizard.

Domain Name Server Configuration

The DNS settings can be added automatically by selecting the *Read DNS Setting from this computer* button. This will transfer the DNS settings from the current computer into ThinManager.

The DNS settings can be manually added by selecting the *Add DNS Server* button to launch a **DNS Server** dialog box that allows the IP address of the DNS server to be entered.

Domain Name Server Configuration - Add DNS Server

Add the IP address of the DNS server into the **DNS Server** dialog and select **OK**. Additional IP addresses can be listed by selecting the **Add DNS Server** button again.

Additional Settings include the *Domain* field is for the DNS domain name and the *Search Domain* field. This field will be added as a prefix to any DNS searches.
